

SVOMPT rule is very important if you want to learn the construction of sentences in English.

SVOMPT stands for:

SVOMPT

John	rides	his bike	quickly	in the park	every day	
The student	studied	English	hardly	in his classroom	yesterday	

Usually the manner, place, or time, are in that order within a sentence, but they can change position among themselves and also within the sentence. This gives more importance to how, where, or when something happens as opposed to the subject, verb, or object, but it can also change the meaning of a sentence.

For example, if you want to give more importance to the manner, then you would say: John rides his bike in the park everyday, quickly.

If you want to give more importance to the place, then you would say: John rides his bike quickly everyday in the park

And if you want to give more importance to the time, then you would say: Every day, John rides his bike quickly in the park

The important thing is that when you speak, you need to emphasize the part of the sentence which you want to give more importance to.
