If you arrive to the exam missing any one of the above-mentioned items, you will be disqualified from sitting the exam.

## \*\*\*\* Fall-back Awards

Candidates entered for a Level 1: B1/A2/A1 examination session who do not meet the required criteria for a B1 level will automatically be reassessed at a lower level and can therefore be eligible to be awarded a qualification of the level achieved. In the case of a fail, no certificate will be issued.

Please note, Candidates entered for an Entry Level 1: A1-B1 examination session cannot be awarded a qualification at any level higher than B1. Candidates entered for a Level 2: C2/C1/B2 examination session who do not meet the required criteria for the registered level will automatically be reassessed at entry B1 level and can therefore be eligible to be awarded the B1 qualification. Candidates that register for a level 2 qualification will <u>not be awarded</u> a qualification lower than a B1 level. If <u>any one</u> of the criteria assessed is lower than the B1 level the final grade is FAIL and no certificate will be awarded.
